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The Village Office is located at 27 North Bridge Street. Office hours are 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. and 1:00 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday, unless posted otherwise.

↓ Village Council Meetings are held the 2nd Monday of each month, 7:00 p.m. at the Village Office, unless posted otherwise. Meetings are open to the public.

♣ Documents can be notarized at the Village Office, free of charge.

- List through mid-October. Rental form is available on our website or at the Village Office.
- If you notice a <u>street light out or not functioning properly</u>, you can report it to Consumers Energy at www.consumersenergy.com or call the Village Office.
- ♣ The Village does not have an Animal Control Ordinance. Complaints regarding animals should be directed to Ionia County Animal Control/Shelter at 616-527-9040.
- Residential Refuse and Recycling Services are contracted by the Village through Granger and billed to you quarterly on your water/sewer bill. Granger's recycling calendar and guidelines can be found on our website or at the Village Office. Call the Village Office to make changes to your service, like adding recycling for \$4.00 per month!
- ₩ater/Sewer/Refuse bills are mailed quarterly and are payable by mail (PO Box 312), in person at the Village Office, by drop box outside the Village Office, or at Independent Bank, Saranac. Debit/credit card payments are accepted online at www.govpaynow.com or by phone at 888-604-7888 (3.5% fee applies online, 7% by phone).
- ♣ Property Tax bills are mailed June 30th and are payable by mail (PO Box 312), in person at the Village Office, by drop box outside the Village Office, or by debit/credit card as noted above. Taxes are due (without penalty & interest) by September 14th (postmark not accepted). On September 15th a 4% penalty plus 1% interest per month is assessed and payment must be made to the Ionia County Treasurer.
- ♣ A monthly <u>Budget Pay Program is available</u> for Water/Sewer/Refuse payments. Contact the Village Office if you would like to learn more.
- ✦ You may be eligible for a sewer credit if you fill your swimming pool with Village water. For additional information, contact the Village Office prior to filling your pool.

PLEASE HELP US MAINTAIN OUR FRIENDLY LITTLE VILLAGE BY FOLLOWING THESE IMPORTANT RULES & REGULATIONS, WHICH HAVE BEEN ESTABLISHED TO PROMOTE THE SAFETY AND WELFARE OF ALL VILLAGE RESIDENTS.

- On-premise parking in Residential Zones must be outside of the public right of way and on an improved surface. Further details can be found on page 18-6 of the Village Zoning Ordinance, which can be found on our website or at the Village Office.
- Driving over sidewalks (except at a driveway) and parking on sidewalks is prohibited and creates potential hazardous situations. Please consider the safety of our pedestrians!
- ♣ Owners or occupants of a property must remove snow and ice from sidewalks adjacent to their property within 24 hours from time of accumulation.
- **♦** Owners/occupants of property must maintain grass and weeds below 12 inches in height.
- Leaves, yard waste, and brush are picked up by Village crews on a regular basis. Leaves and yard waste must be in biodegradable bags. Brush and branches must be in manageable piles. Please refrain from blowing yard waste into streets. See specific guidelines on our website or at the Village Office.
- ♣ Yard signs are not allowed within a Village road right-of-way and will be removed by Village personnel. The right-of-way is approximately 33 ft. from the center of the road, in each direction.
- Refuse & Recycling containers are to be placed in the front yard near the road no earlier than noon the day prior to pick-up & removed no later than 7 p.m. the day of pick-up.
- Open burning (with the exception of campfires) is not allowed. See specific rules/regulations and complete ordinance on our website or at the Village Office.
- A Zoning Permit is required to make changes or additions to your property (including but not limited to; new building, addition, relocation, demolition, fencing, decking, signs & pools). Permit application is available on our website or at the Village Office.
- Operating a business in your home requires a permit. Permit application is available on our website or at the Village Office.
